Aims and objectives

What are your aims and objectives in providing the regulated activities and locations shown in part 3 of this statement of purpose

By putting the patient first, the Practice aims to:-

1. Provide primary care treatment to the highest possible standard for our patient population inclusive of consultations, examinations, and treatment of medical conditions.
2. Provide general management of patients who are terminally ill
3. Provide the management of chronic disease in the manner determined by the patient, in discussion with the patient
